New South Wales Junior Rugby Union and Sydney Junior Rugby Union invite applications for the following Coaching positions for their teams for the Representative season of 2014.

We are seeking applications for coaching roles with the following Representative teams:

We are seeking applications for the following roles within these teams

- **Head Coach**
- **Assistant coaches**
- **Managers**
- **Trainers (optional)**
- **Physio (optional)**
- **Independent Selectors**

Applications are invited from a "Coaching team" as well as from individuals.

It is desirable that Applicants meet the following criteria:

- Accredited Level 2 or 3 coach
- Smart Rugby compliant (compulsory)
- Proven coaching record.

Applicants must be able to attend all required tournaments pertaining to selection and create a disciplined but relaxed environment whilst encouraging team members to continue their Rugby career.

It is expected that the successful applicant will implement training regimes to ensure the teams are competitive whilst maintaining the player's links with their Village Club teams.

Responsibilities of the different coaching roles

SJRU Zone teams are chosen from the NSWJRU State Championships held over the June long weekend.

The coaching team and selectors will choose a squad of players from across each Zone to contest the regionals. Each zone (North, South and West) will select 15 players and then the Barbarians will be allowed select 15 players, following this the zones will choose their reserves players from the available remaining players.

There is usually about a three week commitment to this coaching role.

SJRU Barbarian teams are chosen from the NSWJRU State Championships held over the June long weekend.

The coaching team and selectors will choose a squad of players from across Sydney (that missed their respective zone selection) to contest the regionals. Each zone (North, South and West) will select 15 players and then the Barbarians will select 15 players, following this, the zones will choose their reserves and then the Barbarians will choose theirs. The idea of the Barbarian side is to pick up the skilled players that might slip through the selection net.

The aim is to showcase these players and their skills in the regionals with selections for the Sydney team as the goal, aside from the regional contest itself.

There is usually about a three week commitment to this coaching role.

Sydney Junior teams are chosen from the SJRU Regionals (traditionally held in late June) for the U15 and U16's, and the NSWJRU State Championships held over the June long weekend for the U14, U17's & U18's. The U14's, U17's and 18's will most likely run a possible vs probable game in line with the regional carnival.

The coaching team and selectors will choose a squad of players to contest the annual Sydney vs Country which is generally held in late July.

For the U14's, U15's, U17's and U18's this is usually a three to four week commitment.

For the U16's additionally there is the U16 Nationals at the end of the season (usually in Oct). This role will encompass a much longer timeframe.

NSWJRU Junior teams are selected from the City v Country tournament traditionally held late July.

The coaching team and selectors will choose a squad of players to contest games against other State sides (ACT, Qld) which will generally take place in late September.

There is usually about a four to five week commitment to this coaching role

Independent Selectors are also ideally required for all these teams. We are seeking experienced rugby folk to assist with the selection of these teams at the NSW State Championships, SJRU Regionals and the Sydney vs Country fixtures.
